



Get Ready for Kindergarten!

Prior to registration, every kindergarten age student will meet with one of our teachers for a kindergarten readiness evaluation.

In addition, you may want to consider having your child's vision and hearing tested to uncover any potential problems before they enter the classroom environment.

School Readiness Concepts:

- ❖ Visual Discrimination - Same and Different:
Can your child tell the difference between shapes: i.e. circles and squares?
- ❖ Visual Motor skills:
Can your child draw different shapes such as a circle, a square, and a plus sign?
- ❖ Does your child know their body parts?
Nose, legs, chin, eyes, back, head, etc.
- ❖ Can your child follow positional directions such as:
Put your hands *over* your eyes
Put your hands *above* your head
Show your right and left hand (they will learn more in class)
- ❖ Can your child follow verbal directions such as:
Shake your head
Clap two times
Walk to the door, hop back, and sit down
- ❖ Does your child know personal data such as:
What is your full name?
How old are you?
- ❖ Does your child know about numbers (they will learn more in class)?
Can they count 1-10 (or beyond)
Recognize some written numbers
- ❖ Does your child know about the alphabet (they will learn more in class)?
Say or sing the ABC's
Recognize some of the letters of the alphabet
Write some letters
Write first name
